Alton Shores Association Guidelines for Owners, Guests, and Renters

Alton Shores is a community, please respect the rules and your neighbors while enjoying this beautiful area we have all come to love.

- 1. Guests and renters should display the owner's Beach Pass while using any of the beaches. Note: There are NO LIFEGUARDS
- 2. Beach rules are posted and include: No Dogs, No Fishing, No Throwing Rocks, No Fires, and No Camping. **Please carry out all your trash.**
- 3. All watercraft left on beaches overnight must have a current ASA boat permit or risk removal. Watercraft should be stored on or next to the available boat racks not on the beach.
- 4. There are no moorings at any of the beaches for motorized boats.
- 5. When putting in a boat at the boat ramp, please make sure it is free of milfoil by rinsing before putting in and rinse off after taking out.
- 6. The Town of Alton Noise Ordinance is in effect here from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am and prohibit: "to make, continue or cause to be made or continued any excessive, unnecessary or unusually loud noise or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others." Examples include loud music, fireworks, noisy parties, and shouting.
